



Link Trimble Connect & Viewpoint For Projects (VFP)

1. Open VFP and right click on your project container. Select Trimble Connect.



2. Log in to Trimble Connect (this can be a different login to your VFP login)




3. Ensure you select the correct server for the region you are in – in my case, Europe.




After selecting the correct server for the region, select the project and click “Connect Project”

4. After selecting and connecting the project, VFP will prompt you to invite users from the VFP directory into the Trimble Connect Project.

NB: In the current version of this integration, user permissions do not cascade from VFP to Trimble Connect.




- In this case, I have chosen to add Amanda into the project. Click “Invite People to Project” button on the upper right of the pop up.




The project linking is now complete!

- You are now able to see that the Trimble Connect logo appears on the left of the project structure, and if expanded, the folders contained within the project are visible.




Issuing files from VFP into Trimble Connect


1. Select the file from within VFP, and press “Send to Connect”



2. You will be prompted to select which project you wish for the file to be uploaded to.



3. A toast will appear once the file has been uploaded.



4. If you now login to Trimble Connect, you can see we have a file which carries a tag "From VFP".
